## ImageRight Tip - Deleting Unwanted Images


When you are importing Images and document into ImageRight please remember to delete the images that are not needed. As you can see below the pages 2 through 6 are images that are on the 1<sup>st</sup> page. To delete the images before you import them, click on the page # of the image and press the delete key

Reasons to delete irrelevant images:

- 1. Removes clutter in IR with unnecessary pages in your document
- 2. When emailing to your client or underwriter, irrelevant pages are not part of your document

Please help by deleting the pages in preview before importing them into IR.












