Why do I have to encrypt email?


- Atlas transmits private or sensitive information by email
- It's the law
 - Federal Regulations HIPAA HiTECH
 - State Privacy Regulations
- Establish trust with customers and business partners

The Solution

Zix Email Encryption

- To SEND securely to clients, company underwriters, banks & financial institutions
- To RECEIVE securely from clients, other third parties

I'm Sending an Email How Does It Work?

TRANSPARENTLY!

 Zix scans email content & attachment automatically – encrypts if "Lexicon" match is found

OR TRIGGERED BY YOU

- "Encrypt and Send" Button in Outlook
- Type ENCRYPTME in subject line in Outlook, Webmail or ActiveSync

My Recipient's Experience How Does It Work?

TRANSPARENTLY!

 When Zix sees a secure tunnel – then in the recipient's Inbox

OTHERWISE,

 An email notification in the recipient's Inbox directing them to ZixPort to retrieve/send email

Lexicons - Healthcare

Protected Health Information (PHI)

- 18 identifiers Social Security Number, Date of Service,
 Medical record #, telephone #, fax, email, Health Plan...
- Health information Diagnosis, treatment...

Example:

Here's the info you requested on patient Jane Doe, SS# 123456789. She saw Dr. Smith at General Hospital appox 5/15/2014 and began taking tamoxifen, prescribed for 12 months. Her last visit as of 7/14/2015 shows no cancer.

Lexicons - Financial

Financial

- Financial Terms refinance, deposit, balance transfer
- Financial Identifiers SSN#s, Loan #s, Account #s
- Credit Card Numbers

Example:

This lexicon was too rigorous and replaced by Personal Financial & State Regulation lexicons

Sorry for the delay in getting back to you. Here is the credit card account info: 5403 1500 0001 0000 MasterCard Exp 06/2016

Lexicons –Personal Financial & Credit Card

Financial Identifiers

- SSN, VIN, Account Numbers, but not Policy numbers
 Financial Terms
 - Banking, General Financial terms

Credit Card Numbers

Example:

Sorry for the delay in getting back to you. Here is the credit card account info: 5403 1500 0001 0000 MasterCard Exp 06/2016

03/15/2016 Rev

Lexicons – State Regulation

- Hawaii Drivers License Number (H followed by 8 digits)
- Hawaii State ID Number (A followed by 7 digits)

Examples:

Here is Fox Scully's Hawaii Drivers License H98765432. My HI State ID is Aoo61237.

Lexicons – SSN

Social Security Number SSN

Lexicons - Profanity

Profanity

Will not encrypt but will flag subject line with [Content]

Some Examples:

- Debasement of the referent
- Considered taboo in polite usage
- Vulgarity





ZixPortal

- Retain emails for 60 days
- Upload documents up to 10 MB
- Desktop, laptop, mobile device like smartphone, tablet
- Compose, reply or forward email from the Portal
 - To anyone with an Atlas email address <u>anyone@atlasinsurance.com</u>
- Recipient can save the message or the attachments to their local computer
- Receipt notification to send generated when recipient opens message in ZixPortal




